This includes programs such as: PASSPORT, CareSource, and, Connect 'n' Go.
Opportunities for Ohioans with Disabilities (OOD)	419-747-3000	Provides short term transportation to work and training for individuals with disabilities.
Richland County Job and Family Services	419-774-5400	Provides Richland County Transit Bus Tickets to qualifying persons on a case by case basis, for social service and medical appointments only. Medicaid recipients receive transportation benefits to their managed care provider. Enhanced Medicaid transportation assist with transportation to Medicaid covered appointments. Assistance may be in the form of ambulette, taxi transportation, or gas card.
Richland Newhope Industries (RNI, Inc.)	419-774-4400	Provides transportation to eligible people based on individual needs to and from RNI locations as well as community employment sites.
Richland County Veteran Service Commission	419-774-5822	Provides free of cost transportation to medical facilities. Consumers must call the office to determine eligibility and schedule rides. They must have a file and copy of the DD214.
Goodwill of Akron	800-989-8428	Supports individuals with transportation needs in Summit, Portage, Medina, Ashland, and Richland counties. Richland County residents who need transportation assistance can complete an application for a Richland County transit bus pass on Goodwill of Akron's website.
